The hardware is made of zinc alloy.
- **Minimally Packaging our Cuffs:** We believe that less is more... especially when it comes to packaging. The simple hangtag speaks volumes about us. Handbag Handcuff® packaging and shipping materials are recyclable and can be creatively reused.
- **Sustainably Shipping and Off-setting Emissions:** We have partnered with CarbonFund.org to create a sustainable shipping option to offset the carbon dioxide emissions caused by transporting Handbag Handcuffs®. A 10¢ surcharge amount has been calculated by CarbonFund.org using shipping estimates. Donations will be used to fund projects such as reforestation that will reduce carbon emissions and, in turn, lessen the adverse effects of climate change.
